## Am I Qualified?

- Must be a United States Citizen of at least 21 Years of Age
- Possess a High School Diploma or G.E.D. Equivalence
- No Felony Convictions or Domestic Violence Diversions/Convictions
- Good Physical Condition Required
- Weight must be in Proportion to Height
- Possess a Valid Kansas Driver's License
- Must Pass Vision/Hearing Standards
- Be Willing to Live and Work Anywhere in the State of Kansas
