Warning Signs



- More close calls, or you notice unexplained damage to the vehicle.
- Frequently fails to use the turn signal, or forgets to turn it off.
- Drifts into other lanes.
- Has trouble paying attention to road signs, pavement markings, or pedestrians.
- Drives on the wrong side of the road, or on the shoulder.
- Misses highway exits, or backs up after a missed turn.
- Confuses the gas and brake, or has trouble moving between them.
- Feels more nervous behind the wheel.
- Increased traffic tickets or warnings.
- Gets lost more often.
- Passengers are reluctant to ride with the driver, or you are reluctant to allow anyone to ride with them.
